25 May – 4 June 2017 “Thy Kingdom Come”

The Archbishops of Canterbury and York are asking us to pray! The 10 days between Ascension and Pentecost are traditionally a time of focused prayer as we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit. “Thy Kingdom Come” is a global wave of prayer during those ten days: 25 May – 4 June. How can you commit yourself to pray for the world,

our country, our community and your friends during this time?

Here in the Great Grimsby team we are holding two guided prayer events in the Lady Chapel:

Friday 26 May 12 noon – 1pm: 60 minutes praying the Lord’s Prayer

Friday 2 June 12 noon – 1pm: 60 minutes praying for our nation

We will also produce copies of daily prayers to use at home, or during your lunchbreak at work.

Nationally, Cathedrals across the country are holding beacon events to celebrate this wave of prayer. In **Lincoln Cathedral** the beacon event is on **Saturday, 3rd June at 7.30pm**. Please speak to Louise Vincer if you would like to go.

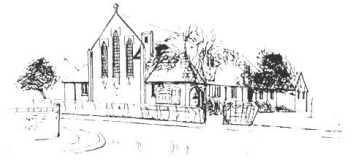

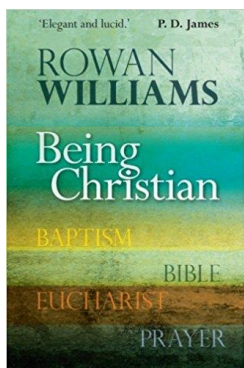
